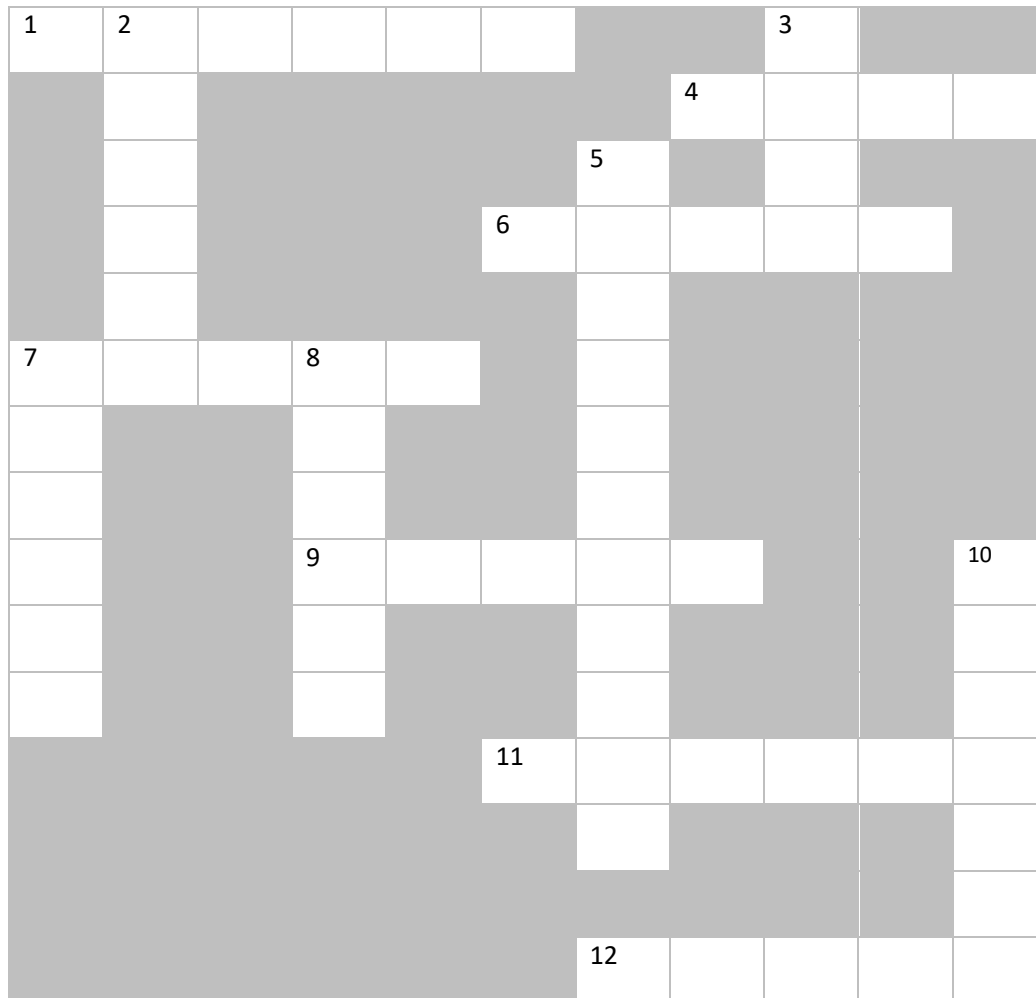


## FLORA & FAUNA OF MADAGASCAR CROSSWORD PUZZLE



### ACROSS

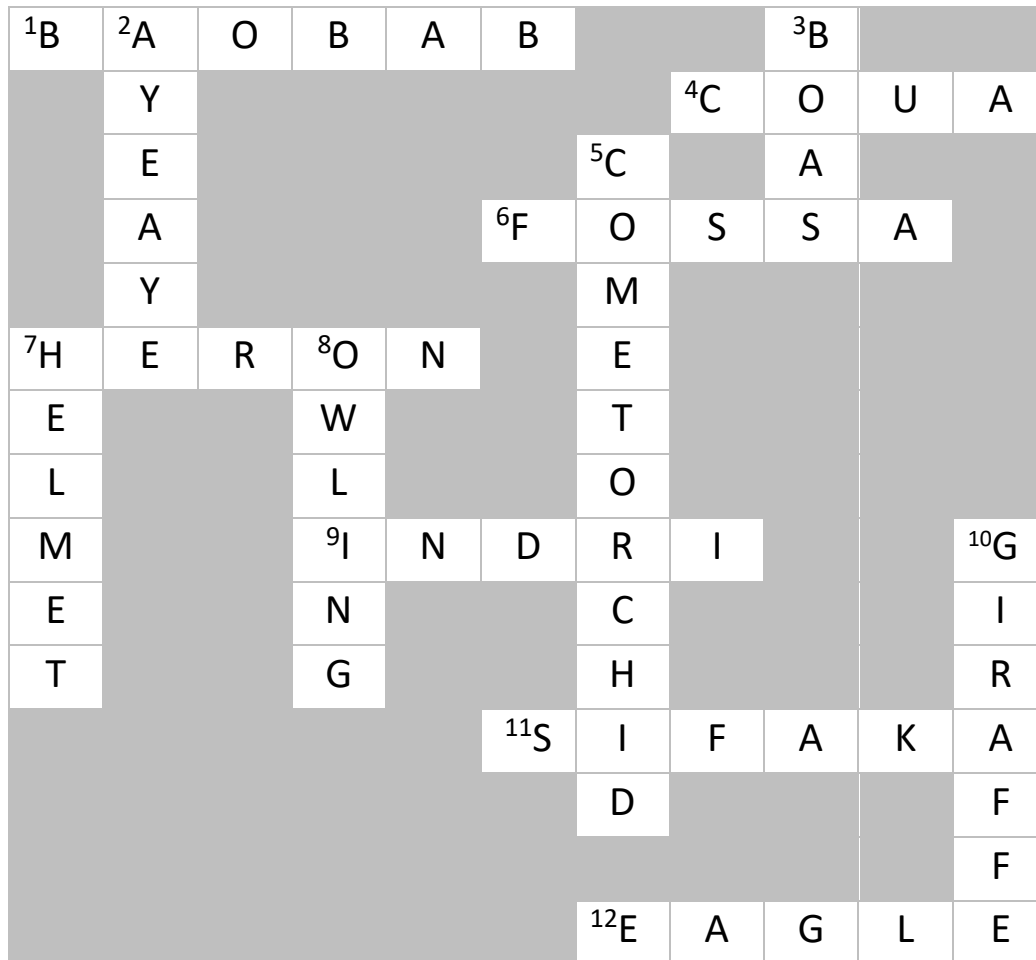
1. A long-lived tree with a trunk that is wide at the base, and gradually more tapered towards the top
